THE TISCH MS RESEARCH CENTER'S MISSION IS TO CONDUCT MEDICAL RESEARCH DIRECTED TOWARD FINDING THE CAUSE AND EVENTUAL CURE OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS. SOME OF THE PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: WE HAVE MADE ADVANCES IN OUR STEM CELL RESEARCH. IN 2016 WE COMPLETED THE FDA-APPROVED PHASE I CLINICAL TRIAL TESTING STEM CELLS IN MS PATIENTS AND GAINED FDA APPROVAL TO BEGIN A PHASE II TRIAL. DR HARRIS (SENIOR RESEARCH SCIENTIST) AND DR SADIQ (CHIEF RESEARCH SCIENTIST) PUBLISHED A PILOT STUDY DESCRIBING CLINICAL SAFETY OF STEM CELL TREATMENT IN 6 MS PATIENTS. WE HAVE MADE ADVANCES IN OUR BIOMARKER RESEARCH, AND DR HARRIS, DR MIR (RESEARCH SCIENTIST), AND DR SADIQ HAVE ALL PRESENTED ABSTRACTS AT THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF NEUROLOGY CONFERENCE IN VANCOUVER CANADA DESCRIBING NOVEL CEREBROSPINAL FLUID BIOMARKERS. ADDITIONAL ADVANCES WERE MADE IN UNDERSTANDING MECHANISMS OF DISEASE PROGRESSION AND DR. CRISTOFANILLI AND SADIQ HAVE PUBLISHED A STUDY DESCRIBING A NOVEL AUTOANTIGEN IN MS. DRs CRISTOFANILLI AND SADIQ See Form 990, Page 2, Part III, Line 4a (continued)
